Application for S.1 Discretionary Places (Admission in September 2020)

Information on Selection of Applicants

1. Number of discretionary places for admission to Secondary One in September 2020:
43
2. Approximately 200 applicants will be invited for interviews with reference to applicants' **conduct, academic achievement (40%) and performance in extra-curricular activities (15%)**
3. The **individual interview** accounts for **45%** of the overall assessment based on applicants' proficiency in Chinese and English, knowledge of Mathematics and Science, General Knowledge and communication skills.
4. To recognize applicants' achievements in areas other than academic work, applicants with outstanding performance in Music and/ or Sports will be separately selected for interviews. These applicants should provide relevant proofs of their achievements (*e.g. results of Inter-primary Schools Sports Awards, Instrumental Graded Examination Certificates, etc.*) and should have attained an acceptable academic standard. Overall assessment for admission is based on applicants' conduct, achievements in extra-curricular activities, their performance in the interview and the **auditions or sports trials**. About 20 applicants will be selected for interviews in this category and the quota for admission **will not exceed 7**.
5. Parents are strongly advised to study the terms stipulated in the application form carefully before submitting the application for their children. The application form can be downloaded from the school's homepage starting from 2nd December 2019. For further details of the processing procedure, please refer to the Working Schedule overleaf.
