- 2. The criteria for the selection of S1 Discretionary Places are as follows:

Admission Criteria	With Interview* (Approx. 200 applicants)	Without Interview# (Due to Covid-19 related circumstances)
Conduct and Academic Achievements	40%	70%
Extra-Curricular Activities and Services	15%	30%
Performance in Interview	45%	

- * The **individual interview** accounts for 45% of the overall assessment based on applicants' proficiency in Chinese and English, knowledge of Mathematics and Science, General Knowledge and communication skills.
- * To recognize applicants' achievements in areas other than academic work, applicants with outstanding performance in Music and/ or Sports will be separately selected for interviews. These applicants should provide relevant proofs of their achievements (e.g. results of Inter-Primary Schools Sports Awards, Instrumental Graded Examination Certificates, etc.) and should have attained an acceptable academic standard. Overall assessment for admission is based on applicants' conduct, achievements in extracurricular activities, their performance in the interview and the auditions or sports trials. About 20 applicants will be selected for interviews in this category and the quota for admission will not exceed 7.
- # If the interview cannot be conducted due to Covid-19 related circumstances, applicants with outstanding performance in Music and/ or Sports will be selected based on the applicants' relevant proofs of their achievements (e.g. results of Inter-Primary Schools Sports Awards, Instrumental Graded Examination Certificates, etc.) and should have attained an acceptable academic standard. The quota for this category will not exceed 7.
- 3. Parents are strongly advised to study the terms stipulated in the application form carefully before submitting the application for their children.
