

Queen's College Parents-Teachers' Association Annual Report 2017-18



The Queen's College Parents-Teachers' Association (PTA) was established in 1989 and was in its 29th session during 2017-18. With devoted support from the school and the parents, a series of events and activities were organized with great success.

Annual General Meeting

The 29th Annual General Meeting of the PTA was held at the school hall on 20 October 2017 with 120 participants. After listening to campaign speeches from parents running for the Executive Committee of the PTA, our members cast their votes. Six parents were elected to join six incumbent parents and seven teachers in the Executive Committee. Meanwhile, Mr. Kwong Wing Ho Ringo replaced newly retired Mr. Yeung Hon Yuen as our Honorary Lawyer. Mr. Tam Kam Tong continues to serve as the Honorary Auditor for the PTA.

The First Executive Committee Meeting of Session 2017-18 was held immediately after the Annual General Meeting to elect the post bearers. Mr. Yiu Kwok Hung Kenneth was elected Chairperson of Session 2017-18. Mrs. Wah Chan Cheng Young Sarah, former Chairperson of the PTA, became our new Honorary Ex-officio Member. Major Activities Organized by PTA in 2017-18

During the weekend of 21 and 22 April 2018, 99 participants including teachers, students and parents joined our cross-border outing to Shenzhen and Huizhou.




