The Queen's College Parents-Teachers' Association Annual Report 2019-2020

The Queen's College Parents-Teachers' Association (QCPTA) was established in 1989 and is in its 31st session during year 2019-2020. QCPTA organizes a variety of events every year to foster the linkage between the school and families of QC boys. In addition, the events of QCPTA help connect parents and teachers and enhance their relationship.

2019-2020 is a challenging year. Due to the social situation and COVID-19 pandemic, the "Blood Donation Day" and "Company Visits and BBQ Fun Day" organized on 11 December 2019 and 8 February 2020 respectively were cancelled. To consider public health and keep social distancing, "Annual Open Days" of the school, "Annual Dinner", "Information Day for S3 Parents and Students", "Appreciation Party for Parent Volunteers" and "Second-hand Book Sale and Uniform Donation" were also cancelled. In addition, some activities of QCPTA were also postponed to the second term of this academic year. Nevertheless, as the bridge between the school and parents, QCPTA provided the support and facilitated more communications among them during this difficult time.

Moreover, with the good collaboration of our executive committee members and the devoted support from the school and our fellow members, the events and activities were organized in the first term. Below are the highlights.

Annual General Meeting

The 31st Annual General Meeting of QCPTA was held at the school hall on 24 October 2019 with approximately 100 participants. Six parents were confirmed by participated members to join the Executive Committee with six incumbent parents and seven teachers. Meanwhile, Mr. Tam King Tong and Mr. Kwong Wing Ho Ringo continues to serve as our Honorary Auditor and Honorary Legal Advisor for QCPTA respectively.

However, the event was cancelled due to the spread of COVID-19.

For our students who consider studying abroad, QCPTA co-organized a "Overseas Study Online Talk" with the Career and Life Planning Team of the School on 11 July 2020 which included universities information of the United Kingdom and the United States of America. We also invited our current S6 student and parent to share their experience. This event was the first online activity of QCPTA. The feedback was overwhelming. More than 200 parents and students joined this event.

Appreciation for Parent Volunteers

An "Appreciation Party for Parent Volunteers" on 20 June 2020 was cancelled due to the pandemic. However, to appreciate the contributions and efforts made by parent volunteers, QCPTA presented electronic copies of Certificate of Appreciation to our parent volunteers.

Parent Education Programme

To provide a platform where parents can interactively learn from each other, a new Parent Education Programme was organized to be held from May to September 2020. The programme includes focus groups, workshops, talks and sharing sessions by professionals, parents and QC old boys in order to strengthen the parenting skills and help parents nurture their children in a supportive home environment. However, due to the spread of the epidemic, the programme was suspended.

Social Service Team

To increase opportunities to serve the society and enhance the enthusiasm for participating in social affairs, QCPTA established the Social Service Team to provide participating parents and their families with a platform and opportunity to serve the society and improve themselves.
