Annual Report 2021-2022

The Queen's College Parents-Teachers' Association (QCPTA) was established in 1989 and is in its 33rd session during year 2021-2022. QCPTA organizes a variety of events every year to foster the linkage between the school and families of QC boys. In addition, the events of QCPTA help connect parents and teachers and enhance their relationship.

This year is the 160th anniversary of Queen's College. QCPTA arranged an event "2022 'Walk with You' 1.60 km Fund-raising Challenge". Although the pandemic and social distancing protocols meant the event was held on a virtual basis, the activity was successfully held during the period from 12 August to 12 September 2022. The fund raised is for the events of the 160th Anniversary of Queen's college and the QCPTA Scholarship. We would like to thank all the participants for supporting QCPTA.

In the past year, in response to the epidemic, the activities of QCPTA inevitably had to be changed. The arrangements of our activities were adjusted with due consideration of the epidemic situation. Therefore, different options were prepared to cope with various emergencies when organizing activities. On account of public health and social distancing measures, some activities, such as "Member Activities", "Annual Dinner" and "Second-hand Book Sale and uniform Donation" were cancelled this year.

Moreover, with the good collaboration of our executive committee member and the devoted support from the school and our fellow members, a number of events and activities were organized. These help to keep our members connected and focused on objectives central to the needs of our children, families, and the school. Below are the highlights.

Annual General Meeting

The 33rd Annual General Meeting of QCPTA was held at the school hall on 15 October 2021 with approximately 100 participants. Six parents were elected by participating members to join the Executive Committee with six incumbent parents and seven teachers. Meanwhile, Mr. TAM King Tong and Mr. KWONG Wing Ho Ringo would continue to serve as our Honorary Auditor and Honorary Legal Advisor for QCPTA respectively.

The First Executive Committee Meeting of Session 2021-2022 was held immediately after the Annual General Meeting to elect the post bearers. Mr. LAM Wai Lam William was elected to be the Chairperson of Session 2021-2022. The composition of the Executive Committee 2021-2022 is as follows.

Parent Volunteers Appointment Kick-off Ceremony and Appreciation Party

The Appreciation Party for Parent Volunteer was held on 3 August 2022. Thank you for the volunteers' dedication to the QCPTA. During the event, the whole year's activities was reviewed and parents' opinions were collected as a reference for planning the future activities.





Parent Academy

In order to promote parental education in our school, QCPTA launched the "Parent Academy" in the school year 2021-2022, with the objectives of further enhancing parent-child relationship and introducing Fintech to our parents. Seminars of various topics were arranged by inviting experts in different fields to share their invaluable tips. Three Parent Academy events were organized this year. Parents who have attended at least two of the thematic talks and have completed the evaluation and self-reflection would be awarded Graduation Certificates.

The first thematic online talk was "Bringing positive energy to your family", which was held on 2 April 2022. It was delivered by Mr. Jacob YU. More than 140 parents and students joined this event.





The second thematic talk, with topic "How to raise an emotionally intelligent child" was held on 11 June 2022 and was delivered by Dr. Charles YU. In the talk, parents were introduced to negative emotions and their coping strategies so that they could understand how to guide their children. Parents could attend the talk at school hall or online.



The third thematic talk was delivered by Ms. Ivy AU-YEUNG, the Chief Executive of OCBC Wing Hang Bank Limited, Hon. Duncan CHIU, Legislative Council Member (Technology & Innovation Constituency) and Ir. Eric CHAN, the Chief Public Mission Officer of the Hong Kong Cyberport. Our Chairman, Mr. William LAM, as the host, conducted a wonderful sharing session with the guest speakers. The talk gave parents a deeper understanding of the latest fintech and encouraged youngsters to seize the opportunities brought by the development of financial technology.










Live Broadcast of Information Day for Secondary 3 Parents and Students

Overseas Study Online Talk

An online overseas study talk was held on 23 July 2022 by the Career & Life Planning Team and QCPTA. Seven alumni, who are now studying in the United Kingdom, U.S.A., Canada and Australia, were invited to share their experience on how to prepare for the entrance examinations of universities, the admission requirements of difference countries, and the differences between the academic systems of different countries. Over 100 students and parents joined the online talk.





Queen's College's 160^{th} Anniversary Event – 2022 'Walk with You' 1.60 km Fundraising Challenge

This year is the 160th Anniversary of Queen's College. In order to promote health and family cohesion, one of Queen's College's 160th Anniversary events – 2022 'Walk with You' 1.60 km Fund-raising Challenge was held during the period from 12 August to 12 September 2022. Participants were required to complete a self-selected route of 1.60 km or more, upload an app screenshot of the completed record, and a photo to the link provided by QCPTA on or before 12 September 2022. All participants who successfully registered for the activity would receive one T-shirt as a souvenir. Participants who have completed the whole journey and uploaded a corresponding record would receive an electronic certificate of participation. There were five prizes, including three prizes for Top Fundraiser (Individual section, Parent-Child section and Open section), the Longest Distance and the Best Photo for all participants. The prizes were presented to winners on 20 October 2022.

The Queen's College Old Boy's Association also supported the school and the event. More than 180 parents, students and alumni signed up the event, showcasing their generosity and dedication. The funds raised after the expenses and administration charges were deducted would be used for the events of the 160th Anniversary of Queen's College and QCPTA Scholarship.




Our Social Service Team volunteered during the Wan Chai District Vaccination Day for Students on 6 August 2022 held at the school hall.
